We will not let that happen.

We have worked too hard for too long to allow management to frustrate our good faith attempts to bargain fair contracts that meet the needs of our membership and acknowledge the important role Steelworkers play in every aspect of the company's success.

As negotiations continue, please continue to work safely and stand together.
